ACCOMMODATION

Staying on the village of Mt Baw Baw is highly recommended, as the next closest town is over an 46 kilometres away. Crews leave from the summit each morning, and return here each night. The Mt Baw Baw Resort Management board manage majority of the accommodation on the mountain - event dates have been blocked out & competitors get priority bookings. Also, you are able to contact guest services on 03 5165 1136. They can provide assistance for accommodation that isn't available online.

DINING/MEALS

While dining options are limited on the mountain, event organisers liaise with resort management on crews attending the event. Breakfast, coffee, additional meals & snacks will be available for purchase from the Village Central Cafe each event day. Lunches for drivers & navigators will be provided by ATR as part of your entry fee, along with your Saturday night meal at the competitors & officials dinner. Some accommodation venues have self-catering facilities - please check when making your booking.

SERVICE CREW/SERVICE PARK

We find service crew isn't essential for our Mt Baw Baw Sprint event as the course returns to the summit twice through-out the day, with one stop being a dedicated service break.

If you do wish to bring along service crew, they may base themselves in the upper carpark (fuel must remain in the designated refuelling area) or at Tanjil Bren - please note: space is limited at this end of the course.

FUEL

We highly recommend you bring an appropriate amount of fuel with you to see you through the weekend. There is VERY limited fuel available in the surrounding towns which make it difficult to refuel either while you're out on the course or once your day is complete. You will be able to leave fuel at the top of Baw Baw in the designated refuelling and service area and access it as necessary at lunch time and after our return at the end of the day.

TRAILER/TRANSPORTER PARKING

Trailer parking is limited in the upper carpark/service area, but ample parking is available in the lower carpark for both trailers & transporters. This is located about 200m from the upper carpark and is the same area as the designated refuelling zone. **Please contact us directly if you are bringing a truck/transporter as we need to arrange a time slot to get up the mountain.**

RECONNAISSANCE

Reconnaissance for our events are highly recommended to familiarise yourselves with the stages & road conditions. Please allow roughly half a day - three quarters of a day prior to the event to complete recce.

Reconnaissance notes will be sent out approx. 4 weeks before the commencement of the event.

TOILETS

Toilets are located in the upper carpark at the Mt Baw Baw Summit, as well as at the other end of the course at Tanjil Bren.

No BYO toilet required!
